

The Torquay Netball Club has made significant strides both on and off the court this season. With fewer changes at the committee level in 2024, we were able to build on initiatives from previous years while also exploring new avenues for growth and community engagement.

#### Off-Court Achievements

Our committee has worked tirelessly behind the scenes to ensure the smooth operation of the club. I'd like to acknowledge the efforts of Sarah Bumpstead, Meagan Mifsud, Sandra McKie, Tess Bramham, Steve Blackley, Caity Hickey, Ilona Sliwa, Annie Ross, and Anna Carty. A special mention goes to Katherine Taylor, who laid the groundwork as President for the 2024 season before stepping aside to pursue her business start-up.

This year, we introduced new initiatives and continued with some long-standing traditions:

- Fundraising Success: Our Pink Day fundraiser remains a cornerstone event, raising over \$6,000 for Breast Cancer Awareness. Additionally, we hosted three junior clinics during school holidays, introducing new families to the club and giving our senior players a chance to mentor juniors. These clinics were not only a great way to connect with the community but also helped inspire the next generation of players.
- Past Players and Life Member Events: During the season, we celebrated the 10-year anniversary of our B-Grade and U/13 Division 1 premierships, bringing together past and present players. These events provide an opportunity to reflect on our history and honor our Life Members who have shaped the club.
- Community Engagement: Recognising the diverse interests of families within our community, we made a deliberate effort to create an inclusive environment by adding additional junior teams. This decision allowed more families to participate in netball, particularly those who are also involved in other sports such as football and cricket. By accommodating more players and their families, we strengthened the sense of belonging within the club and reinforced our commitment to being a hub for the broader community.

#### **On-Court Achievements**

Our senior teams demonstrated exceptional talent and resilience this season, with all teams (A to E Grade) qualifying for finals. A-Grade, led by Coach Sonia Harris, had a strong campaign, finishing in the Preliminary Final. B-Grade, under Robyn Austin's guidance, had a memorable Preliminary Final victory but fell just short in the Grand Final against Geelong Amateur. Both teams showed incredible determination and skill throughout the season.

Developing our juniors remains a priority. This year, we fielded a record 17 junior teams, an achievement that reflects the growing interest in netball within our community. The Under 13 Division 1, 2, and 4 teams delivered outstanding performances, all bringing premiership cups back to the club. We extend our heartfelt thanks to all junior coaches—past players, parents, senior players, and older junior players—for their dedication and effort in nurturing our young talents. Their mentorship has been invaluable in fostering both skill development and a strong sense of community.

Our junior players demonstrated remarkable growth, supported by senior players who took on coaching roles. Training sessions were well-attended across all age groups, reflecting the dedication of our players and coaches. These sessions focused not only on individual skills but also on teamwork, strategy, and building camaraderie among players.

A major milestone for the club this year was the introduction of our Under 19 State League team.
